

Fundraise for Team Jack

Team Jack is asking you to raise research funds. Fundraising can be done by kids or adults at any time throughout the year and earn some nice prizes! Childhood brain cancer affects 4,600 kids each year and is the leading cancer cause of death in children. Children with brain cancer are taking outdated, toxic treatments and survivors are oftentimes left with lifelong side-effects. Due to the lack of federal funding for research, private foundations like Team Jack are left to carry the torch. We are happy to do this, but we need all hands-on deck.

Although the fundraising program is open to any age, getting children involved can benefit them in a variety of ways:

- **Fundamental Skills:** Fundraising teaches children and young adults how to set goals and work toward achieving these goals. In addition, it teaches them fundamental skills of teamwork, creativity and communication.
- **Civic Responsibility:** Doing things to help others at a young age is an important quality to develop for adulthood.
- **Impact:** Raising funds to support a cause can help save lives not only in Nebraska but nationwide.

Funding laboratory and clinical research may seem like climbing a mountain and much too difficult. However, because someone funded research in previous years our namesake, Jack Hoffman, can receive clinical trial medicine to help keep his tumor at bay. In addition, a trial drug that we heavily invested in called TAK580 (now DAY101), has recently been purchased by a pharmaceutical with the goal of receiving fast-track approval by the FDA. This drug that has been developed because of laboratory research nearly a decade ago. New treatments need time to develop and funding as well, and we are excited that this one is helping kids now in trials but will soon be available on the market.
